

PORTUGUESE - INTERMEDIATE, MICROCREDENTIAL

Saint Louis University's microcredential in intermediate Portuguese is an academic microcredential consisting of six required credit hours. Satisfactory completion of the required courses allows the student to develop the necessary skills to conduct intermediate-level/ B1 communication in Portuguese by acquiring appropriate vocabulary, grammar, reading, writing, listening comprehension, speaking capabilities, and an introduction to Portuguese-speaking culture.

The microcredential in intermediate Portuguese aligns itself with similar programs both in SLU's Department of Languages, Literatures, and Cultures in St. Louis and at Saint Louis University-Madrid, in that it is designed to help students gain a broader understanding of themselves, as well as the languages and cultures of others.

Continuation Standards

Students must earn a grade of "C" or better in each required course. Students who do not achieve the "C" or better grade in a required course will be expected to repeat the course in an attempt to achieve the "C" or better grade. Students may repeat a required course one time. Failure to achieve the "C" or better grade after one repeat attempt will have the student dismissed from the microcredential in Intermediate Portuguese.
