## SOCIOLOGY, BACHELOR'S TO M.S. ACCELERATED PROGRAM

Saint Louis University's accelerated bachelor's/master's program offers the opportunity for outstanding sociology majors to begin a master's program in their senior year, completing the M.S. in Sociology with a full-time fifth year of graduate study after successful completion of both the first-year graduate requirements and undergraduate degree and major.

## Requirements

Saint Louis University's sociology major, like most humanities majors, requires 30 credits of coursework, and the master's degree requires a further 30. By counting two graduate courses, or six credits, for both degrees, students earn the requisite 30 credits in only 12 to 14 months after receiving their bachelor's degree.

## **Continuation Standards**

Students who pursue a major in sociology must earn a 2.00 GPA in the courses approved for completion of the major or minor. If a student's minor GPA drops below 2.00, the student will be placed on academic program probation within the department. A student may remain on academic probation for no more than two consecutive semesters, or for three semesters total, before being dismissed from the minor.
