ANCIENT GREEK - INTERMEDIATE, MICROCREDENTIAL

Saint Louis University's microcredential in intermediate ancient Greek consists of six required credit hours. Satisfactory completion of the required courses would allow the SLU student to develop the necessary skills to conduct intermediate-level comprehension in ancient Greek through the acquisition of appropriate vocabulary, grammar, reading, writing, listening comprehension, speaking capabilities, and an introduction to cultures using ancient Greek as a language to communicate.

Continuation Standards

Failure to achieve the "C" or better grade after one repeat attempt will have the student dismissed from the microcredential in Intermediate Ancient Greek.
